

Fourth Annual Wild Goose Chase (2024)

When: Saturday 8 Jun 2024, 0600hrs. Rain date Sunday 9 Jun 2024
Where: southern trailhead Wild Goose State Trail on highway 60

Wild Goose Chasers, this year's ride will again be a fundraiser for the Pelican Path Trail and you will receive the highly-sought-after Fourth Annual Wild Goose Chaser moisture-wicking shirt the day of the ride. The ride is 70 miles round trip, but please join us for any length less than that if you like. You can start with the group then turn around whenever you like, or join the peloton somewhere along the route.

0600 start at Wild Goose State Trail trailhead on highway 60 in Clyman
0700 Stop at Artesian well in Burnett for water top off
0900 Stop at snack/water stop at Oakfield Village Park in Oakfield (Hosted by Lisa Traugher. *Be sure to turn right on Church street in front of the Clark station, then right on 2d Street or you may miss the park*)
1000 Turn around at northern trailhead in Fond du Lac
Stop at Katy's log cabin in Oakfield for lunch
Stop at Chance's Bar and Grill (*follow sign from trail*) or the speakeasy in Burnett for rehydration [*right on Main, left on Depot, then first right. Speakeasy (Copper Bell) on right*]
Stop at Juneau Lanes (*turn right on Oak street then go about 3 blocks. Juneau Lanes is at 150 E. Oak Street on your left*)
Load your bike at southern trailhead and drive to Mocha Vino Bistro (Hustisford) to celebrate

This year's shirt is in the final stages of design and when finished, the design can be viewed on the Pelican Path website at www.pelicanpath.org. Remember this is a FUNDRAISER and registration fees are non-refundable. The ride cost (\$50) is consistent with other rides in Wisconsin if you look at the Wisconsin Bike Federations's Ride Guide. All profits will go into the Pelican Path Trail account with the Friends of Dodge County Parks, Inc. [a 501(c)(3) non-profit]. **You must register by 15 May 2024 to receive the shirt.**

We will have a SAG (Support and Gear) wagon, but try to bring a spare tube, pump, etc. and be as self-supporting as possible. We highly recommend the use of helmets, proper riding etiquette (riding single file on the right when traffic is present), sun screen, and don't forget to bring a water bottle. FYI, when you arrive at the ride site, you will be asked to signed a liability waiver.
